**FINAL JUDGMENT**


On October 5, 2020, this court held a bench trial in this cause and granted Diocesan Migrant & Refugee Services, Inc.’s motion for judgment as a matter of law. On October 16, 2020 this court entered its “Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law” [ECF No. 44] pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 52(a)(1).

Accordingly, the court enters its Final Judgment pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58 as follows:

1. It is **HEREBY ORDERED** that Defendant United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) must conduct a new search for documents responsive to Diocesan Migrant & Refugee Services, Inc.’s (“DMRS”) FOIA request within **fourteen days** of the date of this order.
2. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that ICE must cooperate with DMRS to choose appropriate custodians and search terms. In furtherance of this cooperation, ICE must provide DMRS with staff directories within **seven days** of the date of this order.
3. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that all material produced to DMRS on June 25, 2020 redacted pursuant to exemption (b)(5) must be unredacted and produced to DMRS within **seven days** of the date of this order.
4. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** all pending motions, if any, are **DENIED AS MOOT**.

5. It is **FURTHER ORDERED** the Clerk of the Court is **INSTRUCTED** to **CLOSE** the cause.
